What will we be asking of you?

We have all kinds of tasks, and so we welcome you to consider to help us- at the level that suits your abilities/desire. Our construction tasks will be overseen by our contractor, Jason Leach.

Construction Skills needed:

- Helping put up the greenhouse
- Building benches for classroom alcove
- Building raised beds
- Building raised beds
- Constructing base and counter for outdoor sink
- Helping hook up the sink

Heavy or moderate effort:

- Mulching and weeding beds
- Transplanting plants
- Spreading ground cover under greenhouse
- Tilling up grass for raised beds area
- Hanging up chalk boards
- Filling raised beds with compost and soil
- Setting up tool shed, installing shelves
- Setting out work benches and tables in garden

Light:

- Manning the refreshment stand
- Helping orientate/direct sign in of volunteers as they arrive
- Gopher for errands that may come up
- Supervision of children who are helping to weed or mulch
